Student Complaint Policy

MIAT College of Technology has a Certificate of Approval from the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) to operate a career school or college in the state of Texas. The TWC assigned school number for MIAT College of Technology is S3578.

MIAT College of Technology has a Certificate of Authorization to grant Associate degrees from the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB).

The school's programs are approved by TWC, THECB and by Accrediting Commission of Career Schools and Colleges (ACCSC).

Students must address their concerns about the school or any of its educational programs by following the grievance procedure outlined in the Student Catalog.
